

Wound Care Instructions Punch Biopsy

Dr. Domingues performed a **Punch Biopsy**.

INITIAL DRESSING CARE

 □ Initial dressing stays in place for 24 hours. Keep the dressing dry. □ After you remove the initial dressing, you may shower.
DAILY DRESSING CARE Wash hands before each dressing change. Change the bandage once daily. Remove the bandage Gently cleanse the wound with soap and water. Then apply a thin layer of ointment (Aquaphor or Vaseline) Cover the wound with a bandaid. Continue wound care until sutures are removed. Keep the wound GREASY with ointment and COVERED at all times until the sutures are removed. Avoid swimming and bathing until sutures are removed.
BLEEDING: □ If light bleeding occurs, apply direct pressure over the wound for 20 minutes with a clean cloth. □ If bleeding continues, repeat this cycle two more times.
DISCOMFORT: □ Keeping the area elevated in the first 48 hours will decrease swelling and discomfort. □ You may ice the area for 10 -15 minutes every hour for the first 24 – 48 hours while awake. □ For pain, take Tylenol (acetaminophen) every 6 hours. □ Avoid alcohol and ibuprofen or other NSAIDs for 3 days. □ DO NOT stop aspirin if you currently take a daily aspirin.
INFECTION: □ Signs of infection include increasing pain, redness, swelling, drainage, red streaks, or fever. If you develop a fever or red streaking, go to urgent care or the emergency room immediately. □ If you experience any signs of infection, call the office right away during working hours.
